Program:	Study Abroad in China
Length of Study:	One academic year
Majors (Courses)	No restrictions. Course availability may vary depending on the institution selected
Language Proficiency:	Chinese language preferred, but not required.
Implementation Period:	Starting Fall 2013 for next five years (each year up to 25 scholarships set aside for qualified AASCU member institution students)

April 22, 2013	Deadline for applications submission to AASCU Office
May 1, 2013	AASCU working with Chinese Embassy for the final candidates selection and submission to China Scholarship Council

July 1, 2013	Notification to application for the placement of Chinese universities
Early Sept, 2013	Students departure to China

Applicants Qualification:

1. Students currently studying in the bachelor's degree programs at AASCU member institutions
2. Strong interests in learning Chinese language and culture (proficiency in Chinese not required)
3. Good academic status with minimum 3.0 GPA.
4. Two recommendation letters from faculty and professional supervisors
5. Statement of interest for the study in China program
6. Student Certification of financial eligibility for international roundtrip airfare

- Living stipend
