
# VSA: Advancing Institutional Data Capacity

The New VSA will offer a suite of products

- National database
  - Integrates national data from IPEDS, NSF, FSA, College Scorecard, and SAM
  - Available for subscribers to download
- Analytic tools
  - Interactive benchmarking reports
  - Key performance metrics
  - Comparison groups
- Education and training
  - Topics to include accessing and using data for decisionmaking, enhancing data literacy, effective communications with data
  - Develop communities of practice around analytics, data, and governance










# Student Achievement Measure More Outcomes for More Students #CountAllStudents

Sam offers three models – associate/certificate, bachelor's, stackedsam reports outcomes for half million more students than federal rate
