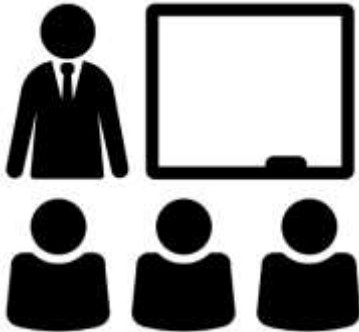

The Student Experience

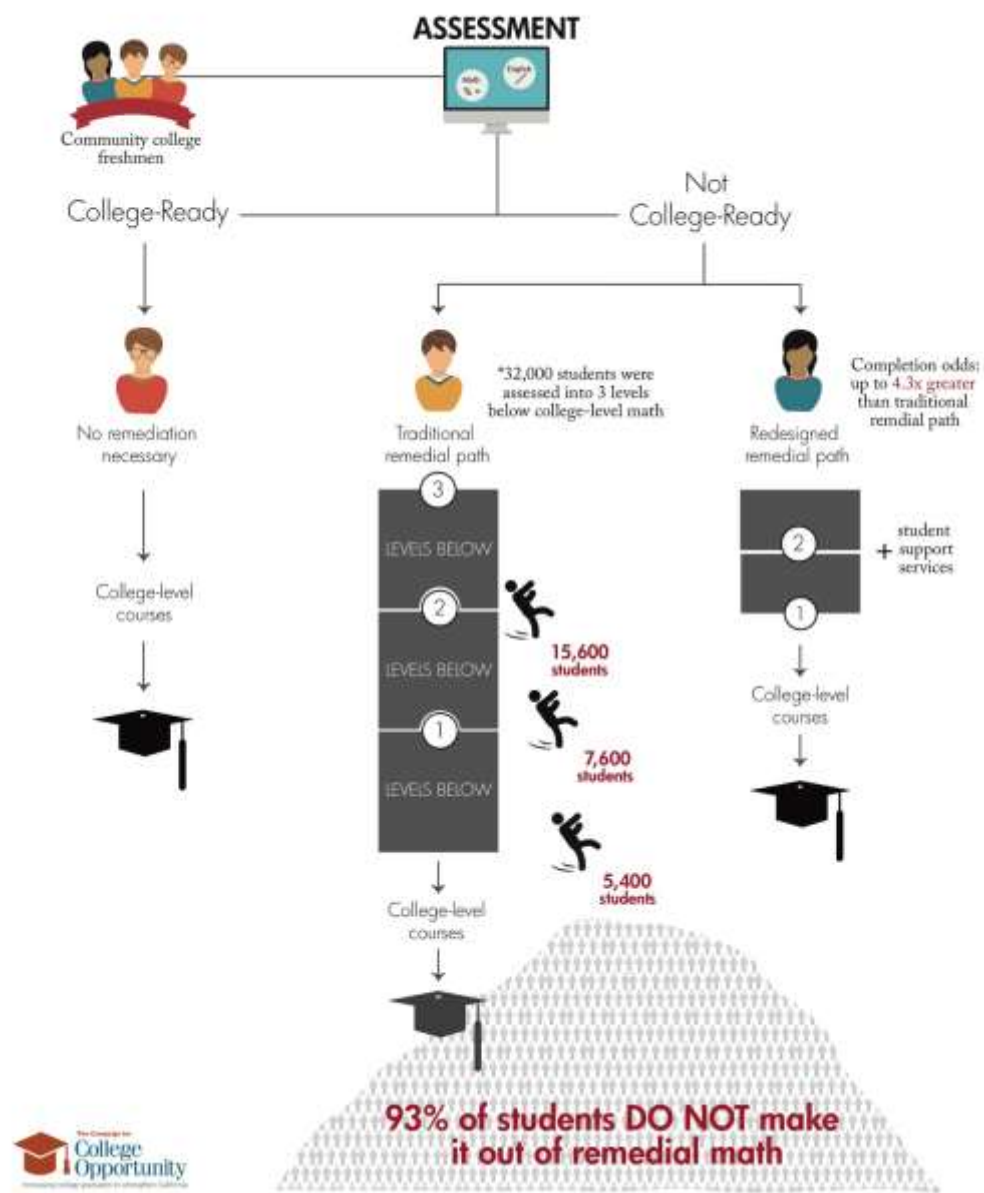


Ben's Story is the norm
