Pre-Conference Workshop | Thursday, June 7, 9:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. (\$50 registration fee)

This day-long workshop introduces participants to numerous tools for educating globally competent citizens. Scholars from 10 AASCU campuses will describe the courses and teaching and learning materials they have developed based on the Center for Strategic and International Studies' 7 Revolutions (population, resources, technology, information, economic integration, conflict, and governance). Workshop leaders will demonstrate the teaching materials and resources they have found most valuable in the courses they teach (introductory, first-year, major, and honors) and will guide participants in anticipating how these same tools could be used effectively on participant's campuses. Participants will also have the opportunity to learn more about how to bring the new national blended-learning course developed by these scholars to their campuses. The courses includes a sample syllabus, readings and other learning materials based on the 7 Revolutions, as well as a set of learning outcomes and quizzes all delivered through the Epsilen eLearning environment.
