The American Democracy Project (ADP) at the American Association of State Colleges and Universities (AASCU) and NASPA are excited to announce the call for proposals is now open for CLDE22 “*Equity and Democracy*”. CLDE22 will take place in Minneapolis, Minnesota on June 21-24, 2022.

CLDE is an annual conference that brings together students, faculty, staff and community partners to build a movement of civic learning and democratic engagement in higher education. As a community we have adopted the [CLDE Theory of Change](#) and strive to create effective strategies and models that strengthen civic learning and democratic engagement.
